

**“Linsanity”**

Even if you're not a fan of the NBA, you may have heard of the term “Linsanity”. The person behind this phenomenon is Jeremy Lin, the first American-born Taiwanese to play in the NBA. His presence has raised the popularity of the sport in Taiwan, where his parents are from. Lin grew up in the States, and has therefore not needed to adapt to unfamiliar surroundings or learn a new language to communicate with his team. His fans look up to him as a symbol of an Asian succeeding in a Western-dominated sport.

Like many Asian athletes in American or European sporting associations, Lin was not the top choice for recruiters at the start of his career. He was captain of his high school's basketball team, leading them to win all but one game in his final year, and was named Northern California Division II Player of the Year. In spite of his successes and awards, he struggled to find a university that would offer him a basketball scholarship. But, eventually, his outstanding academic performance earned him a place at Harvard and he started to play on the university's basketball team. With time, he became a better player, improving more and more. Yet, in his final year, he was not selected by any NBA teams (although, to be fair, it is over 50 years since a player from Harvard played in the NBA). Finally, after being spotted in the NBA Summer League<sup>1</sup>, he received offers from several teams and was able to begin his career.

So, how did the phrase “Linsanity” come to be? Over the course of several weeks while playing for the New York Knicks in 2012, Lin impressed both the crowds and the league with his fierce performance, which helped the team to win seven games in a row. The term “Linsanity” was created at the time and has been following him around ever since.
